Demanding End of Coal Power Plants, Coal Mining and Coal Import

August 20-October 2, 2019

Background: Human have always changed nature. Capitalism, the system we live today, is relatively new. In only selves as well as the planet. But capitalism also represents an enormous growth in the productive forces and hence our ability to transform nature now threatens global ecological and environmental system.

Introduction:

Pakistan Fisherfolk forum (PFF) has plans different weeks of action for climate justice. Strategically the PFF forms steering committees on provincial level and climate justice forum would forms that comprise on expert members from civil society, political parties, media and relevant stake holders from ministry of food, fisheries, agriculture, livestock, Revenue, Social welfare, PDMA, Planning and development department, EPA and health department and other. These committees and forums become instrumental in discussing the climate change and other environmental issues. In addition to this, the PFF carries out various public actions to projects and ventures (coal-fired power generation) that pose threat to environment.

Coal is a dirty energy, its demand and use is expanding in Pakistan. The major factor behind this shift to coal include; Pakistan's increasing demand for energy especially for electricity, its narrative of using coal as cheapest source for energy generation and availability of local coal resources in Tharparker, part of early harvest projects of China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) involving investments of approximately US\$ 13.520 billion for numerous joint energy ventures for coal mining and power generation. Pakistan has a potential of more than 300,000 MW of wind energy. However, the present electricity generation from wind resources does not exceed 500 MW including large potential of solar energy. PFF took out a big Sindh people caravan under the theme of the **Ending the killing coal**.

Mobilization phase :

In order to make caravan successful and meaningful, PFF initiated mobilization and awareness raising first phase started from 20 August and will continue till September 19,2019. This month long phase included sensitization and political education with regards to the need of a socially organized movement for the strong resistance against the use of coal. around 6000 people from fishing



communities, coal affectees, leaders, academia, media and other were sensitized throughout the Sindh province. The people were motivated to participate in the caravan and highlight the issues and raise the public's demands to stop coal in Sindh.

PFF conducted many novel activities under the phase I. It aimed to educate and sensitize the public and other stakeholders about the social, environmental and cultural impacts of the Coal-fired power plants, imported coal and coal mining. PFF believes that it is very important to mobilize regarding the issues and demands of the caravan that would be highlighted and demanded through the 10 days long struggle of the caravan action. Most of these coal projects are settled in the coastal belt and in Tharparkar and these are the places belongs to the indigenous communities.

Mobilization took place into different districts of the sindh including Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Sujawal, Mithi, Umerkot, Sanghar and Hyderabad.

Activities:

SINDH PEOPLES CARAVAN-THE CAMPAIGN PHASE:

Overall Objective:

Demand end of coal import, mining and coal power generation in Pakistan

Specific Objectives of Sindh Peoples Caravan included:

- Formation and of renewable energy policy in Sindh
- Implementation of renewable energy policy in letter and spirit of the law
- Highlight the social and environmental issues resulting from coal import, coal mining and coal power generation in Tharparkar and coastal areas
- Organize and mobilize all concerned stakeholders especially the fishing, pastoralist of Thar and peasant communities affected due to coal import, mining and coal power generation
- To explore the factors damaging health, life, environment and livelihoods of fishing and peasants communities affected by coal mining, coal import and coal power plants.

2-week caravan in Action:

Participants: 100 participants including nearly 50% females participated in the caravan. The participants from fishing and peasant communities belonged to various districts of Sindh. The participants included young and the old alike.



Sindh Peoples Caravan Day One

Launching Ceremony:

The Sindh people caravan formally started with the launching ceremony held on the 26th September, 2019 in the form of the rally. It was participated by the more than 1000 communities including locals, fisherfolk, peasants, youth and activists.

Leading the caravan, PFF's chairperson Muhammad Ali Shah highlighted the social, environmental devastating impacts of the coal transport, coal mining and coal-fired power plants. The unique initiative in the shape of the



caravan was launched to mobilize at the time when country, especially Sindh is experiencing social, political and economic crises.

The ceremony reiterated the demand the stopping mega Thar-projects and port bin Qasim projects. Previous project should be monitored according to the International standards. The participants and speakers of the launching ceremony believed that fishing

and peasant communities have the courage to lead a social movement in the shape of various public actions to protect the environment and indigenous rights.

Groups of Caravan Participants:

At the end of the launching ceremony of Sindh Peoples Caravan, the participants were organized into groups with equal participation of males and females. The groups were oriented about the proceedings of the Caravan by Muhammed Ali Shah who led the action from the front. Team leaders from among the groups were also selected so that discipline throughout the movement could well be ensured.

Sindh Peoples Caravan Day Two

Day two started with the brief meeting of the caravan's participants and set the norms for the caravan. Caravans participants held different activities in the main areas to sensitized the peoples regarding the coal impacts and livelihood issues caused by the corporations.



Chasma goth:

Participants walked in the chasma village.



Razakabad: Welcoming the caravan with the rally. The Caravan was warmly received by hundreds of local residents with flowers and garlands of roses at the entrance of Razakabad.

Gharo, Makli, Thatta: Thatta is an ancient city of the Indus delta. Now 2.4 million acres of the Indus delta invaded by the sea. PFF raised the issues of the sea intrusion during the campaign and also coal impacts.

Sindh Peoples Caravan Day Three

Sujawal Town: The hosts of accompanied the Caravan to the Press Club Sujawal in rally. Media briefings and speeches were held at the Press Club. Afterwards, the Caravan left for next planned destination.

Sujawal, Choochar Jamali: The procession then gathered at crossroad for speeches. Leaders of the PFF body district Sujawal and others accompanying the Caravan spoke on the occasion. Muhammed Ali



Shah, who led the Caravan thanked them for warm welcome and reminded them of the struggle that they were carrying out.

Golarchi, district Badin: The Sindh Peoples Caravan arrived at Golarchi, one of the small towns and markets of district Badin. Hundreds of women, men and children held banners, flowers and garlands as a token of appreciation for the social activists who pledged to raise voice for indigenous rights.



Arrival at Badin: Badin has been one of major districts of the struggle of the PFF. The district has a history of a struggle of rights against the commercial and State forces. A large number of women, men and children received Sindh Peoples Caravan as it entered the city's premises. Fishing communities and the rest of citizens facilitated the rally within the center of the city.

Press Briefings: Having gotten a pleasant reception from the locals of Badin, the Caravan reached at the Badin Press Club where the journalists from various local and mainstream media channels and newspapers welcomed the



leaders and workers of the struggle. The media was briefed as regards the aims and objectives of the Caravan through public speeches and interviews.

Night Stay: The Caravan stayed in Badin after a full day of rallies and speeches highlighting the struggle against coal.

Sindh Peoples Caravan Day four

Rally in village Nindo: Initial meeting with the Caravan participants was held in the morning on day four of the Caravan. Afterwards, a people's march was carried on the dusty rural tracks of village Nindo so that the villagers could have an idea of the impacts of the coal because most of the people of the country are not aware the issues and alternatives of the generating electricity. The rally in the village was attended by the villagers well.



Day rest in Shadi large, village: In Shadi large village, communities warmly welcomed. PFF has strong unit in this village because PFF succeed to abolish the contract on their water. Now, they are free to go for fishing and rehabilitate their livelihood.

Reached at Islam Kot press club: Caravan reached in the city of Islam kot, Tharparker. impacted communities of the Tharparker joined the rally and spoke about the issues they are facing due to the coal related activities. they said that companies have disposing waste water from the coal mining at Gorano dam. The people of gorano get their livelihood through farming and livestock and they are culturally and emotionally attached with the land. PFF find that there issues are purely Human rights issues.

Night stayed with the people of Gorano.

Thari-women joined Caravan: Day Five started with the new energy Thari-women joined Caravan even they are not allowed to go out from home. they bravely shared the issues related to the land, water and food. they said these corporate ruined out right to live.

Umarkot press club: In front of umarkot press club, PFF leaders raised the demand of the campaign and said we will not stop our campaign until Government will not take steps stop using coal and destroying Human Rights.

Bakhoro, Sanghar: Carrying banner of welcome for Sindh Peoples Caravan, the local residents of bakhoro in district Sanghar met with the participants of the Caravan.



Sanghar City: After warmly receiving the caravan, a large number of peasant's fishermen and women took out a rally in Sanghar demanding of

the government to stop using coal to generate electricity and coal mining. The rally covered a distance of more than 5 kilometers raised voice against the State's. Marching along with 100 people caravan were journalists, civil society members, local folk singers and others. Crossing major streets and cross-roads of Sanghar city, the rally reached at the Sanghar press club where the activists from among the caravan participants spoke to the locals. The organizational, associate members and the Chairman, PFF spoke at the press club and reiterated the demands of Sindh Peoples Caravan 2019.

Jamshoro Night: After a hectic and heated day, the Peoples Caravan stayed in Sanghar city where accommodation and dinner was arranged

Sindh Peoples Caravan Day seven

Grand rally Hyderabad: It is a day to unite and undertake joint action to demonstrate that the threats facing humanity, land, rivers, wetlands and oceans are not merely local but global in scope. The day also represents a call for improvement in the policies and practices of decision makers to ensure that deadly projects, in all its forms (Coal mining, local transportation, Import and coal-fired power plant) is used to support life and human dignity. The day was the culmination of Sindh Peoples Caravan that was started on September 26 and concluded on October 2 after turning into a big rally.

Carrying PFF flags, placards and banners inscribed with slogans, the rally was instigated from Shahbaz Building that marched alongside different locations and ended at Press Club. It was participated by 5000 people including civil society activists, government officials, academia, media personnel, women and children hailing from different villages, towns and cities of the Sindh.

Anti-coal plants' caravan reaches Hyderabad

HYDERABAD: The anti-coal plants' caravan that started from Karachi under the aegis of the Pakistan Fisherfolk Forum (PFF) reached Hyderabad here on Wednesday on its seventh and final day.

The protesters demanded an end to the plants producing power on local and imported coal to save the environment.

The participants reached the local press club from Shabbaz Building to call for social and environmental justice.

PFF chairman Mohammad Ali Shah said they had already raised voice against power generation on coal, but now they initiated a regular campaign against such plants of Thar as well as those which were planned on imported coal.

He said Pakistan was moving towards the dangers of coal power plants while several countries in the world had given up producing coal-based energy.

He said Pakistan had a potential of over 300,000MW of wind energy, but present electricity generators from wind resources did not exceed 500MW. Solar energy also had a lot of potential.

He said imported coal was offloaded at Karachi Port and Port Qasim and then dumped at 25 locations without environmental safeguards.

Data from environmental institutions, after checking air quality of Clifton Block I, II and Shireen Jinnah Colony, revealed presence of dust particles in air which caused respiratory illness, cardiovascular diseases and lung cancer, he added.

He said coal was then transported to various parts of the country in open trains and trucks. Around 10 per cent of coal was lost during the transportation, that too without any environmental and other safeguards.

He said Thar coal power project was directly impacting communities and caused migration, land speculation, water scarcity, degrading air quality, health issues and encroachment of grazing land.

Six-week long campaign against coal

Campaigners will travel through different districts of Sindh during the second phase of the campaign. It will cover more 1,000km of distance over 10 days, starting from Karachi Press Club and ending at Hyderabad Press Club. The second phase of the campaign will last from September 20 to September 30. Initiatives to stop the use of coal have been taken across the world, some of the most notable ones being the 1995 Kyoto Protocols and the more recent Paris Agreement 2016. The initiatives resulted out of realisation that climate change is global concern and if the coal industry pays complete price of electricity generation, the price of electricity will increase three-fold. During the United Nations Summit, Pakistan had committed to decrease its greenhouse gas emissions by 5%, while at home it is expanding its coal industry. PRESS RELEASE
